

DUTIES OF THE CABIN SPONSORS

The cabin sponsor will maintain order in the cabins and make sure the campers abide by all camp rules.

The cabin sponsor should maintain a Christian spirit at all times. Remember, you are to set a good example for the campers.

You will make sure the campers clean their cabin daily, make their beds and keep their clothing in order.

Encourage the campers to shower each day and dress properly for the evening worship services.

Make sure the campers attend all classes, assemblies and worship services. If a camper is sick and not able to attend classes, make sure it is approved by the camp nurse.

Encourage the campers to participate in recreation activities each day.

You will conduct a cabin devotion each evening with your campers. Schedule your devotion to end when the lights out signal is given.

Make sure you and your campers rise and shine each morning when the signal is given. This signal will usually be given each morning at 7:00. No sleeping late please.

You will need to sit close to your campers during services to make sure they behave properly.

Any problems of discipline you cannot handle, please contact the Dean of Men, Dean of Women or Camp Director. Any problems they cannot resolve will be turned over to the camp board for action.

Please be available to serve in the kitchen. We will need about 10 adults to help serve at each meal. If you plan to serve, you will need to go to the kitchen at least 15 minutes early. This will give you time to eat and be ready to serve.

SPECIAL NOTE TO THOSE SERVING: Please do not go behind the counter to prepare your tray. The cooks will be busy finishing the meal and it is very hot around the stove & oven. Someone will be designated to serve you.

When teen camp is in session it will be the responsibilities of the sponsors to help clean the bathrooms each day and organize their campers for kitchen KP duty.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR KITCHEN KP DUTY

Boys' Duties:

Replace the benches.

Clean and collect all trays and utensils.

Carry trays and utensils to proper place for washing.

Mop the floor when the girls have finished sweeping.

Dispose of mop water in the mop sink located in the back of kitchen.

When cleaning trays, separate garbage items from paper items. The garbage items are to be placed in the dumpster and paper items burned in the incinerator located behind the dining hall.

Girls' Duties:

Put napkins, salt and pepper shakers on the tables. Collect those items when the meal is over.

Clean tables when the meal is finished.

Sweep the floor thoroughly before the boys mop.

Be available to assist in putting out ice and drinks for meals.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING THE CABINS

Cabin floors must be cleaned each morning, and trash cans emptied.

All beds must be made neatly. Towels and wash cloths may be hung on the end of the bed or other appropriate place.

Clothing should be hung up neatly.

Suitcases should be kept closed and may be left under the beds or stacked in other areas. Shoes and other items may be arranged neatly under the beds.

Makeup, hair dryers, curling irons and other items that must be left out should be arranged in an orderly manner.

The outside of the cabin should be kept clean each day.

All cabins will be inspected each morning during the first class period. If areas of your cabin need attention, the Deans will leave you a note to that affect.
